

Bainbridge BikeFest ATV Policy

To promote a safe event ATV's will not be allowed at Bainbridge BikeFest.

An ATV is any vehicle designed for off road use including but not limited to 4 wheelers, 3 wheelers, and 2 wheel bikes that are not street legal. Golf carts and low performance side by side utility vehicles, because of their low speed capabilities will be allowed but **ONLY** if they are equipped with both headlights and taillights.

Any other motorized vehicle that is not legal to operate on the streets will not be allowed, such as race cars or race motorcycles.

All vehicles not allowed at BikeFest may not be brought onto the property and will be escorted out the gate.

Motorized wheel chairs and scooters used by persons with handicapped permits **WILL** be allowed.

The decision of the BikeFest Gate Supervisor or the Camper Parking Supervisor will be final as to what constitutes a prohibited vehicle.

Your cooperation to make our event safer is appreciated.

This year 2010, we are starting to allow side by side utility vehicles. They must be low speed and present no greater hazard than a golf cart. Examples but not limited to are the John Deere Gator or the Kawasaki Mule. As with any vehicle, unsafe operation or occupancy will result in removal from the event.
